She is a licensed landscape architect and has worked on projects in both public and private arenas. Projects have ranged in size from designing rooftop terraces to developing master plans for municipal facilities such as golf courses, parks and zoos. Ms. Horn has extensive knowledge of landscape construction, as well as cost estimating. She has collaborated on landscape designs and installations for private estates in the Washington DC area, Long Island, Connecticut, the Caribbean and Colorado with some budgets exceeding \$2 million for landscape alone.

Ms. Horn also was a landscape architectural designer for the Bronx Zoo, where she developed designs and oversaw construction of the Butterfly Garden Exhibit (\$4 million) and the African Wild Dog Exhibit (\$2 million).

Ms. Horn's recent projects with DBI include assessing the landscape damage to numerous hotels, resorts and golf courses damaged by 2017 Hurricanes Harvey, Irma and Maria. Her work includes costs for replacement of plant material, ground cover, topsoil, irrigation systems, decorative (non-structural) retaining walls and soil stabilization material such as rip-rap and decorative stone. Her current projects include two sites in Panama City, affected by Hurricane Florence.
