Mr. Nassof has been involved in the field of environmental and health risk consulting for over 25 years concentrating his work in the areas of industrial hygiene, microbial contamination, insurance defense, infection prevention, and liability minimization. Many of his risk management programs have been adopted as underwriting standards by the insurance industry worldwide and are utilized as risk barometers from which to evaluate emerging healthcare and environmental risks. In the area of wildfire impacts, Mr. Nassof is working with both an independent laboratory and wildfire expert litigation team to provide legally defensible documentation to the insurance industry based upon new standards of wildfire impact evaluation.
